

ADMISSION PROCEDURE FOR FOREIGN CITIZENS AND STATELESS CITIZENS

1. Foreign citizens and stateless citizens have right to enroll higher education on budget basis according to the international treaties of the Russian Federation, Federal Laws or within the quota for foreign citizens and on commercial basis (paid by legal or private persons according to the contract).
2. Foreign citizens, can be admitted within the quota for foreign citizens if they have been officially referred by the Federal Executive Authority according to the state policy and regulations in the field of education. Enrollment for studies within the quota of foreign citizens is carried out by a separate order of the University.
3. Foreign citizens and compatriots stateless, who are living abroad, have the right to obtain higher educational degree according to the same Guidelines for the citizens of Russian Federation, if they follow the requirements of Article 17, Federal Law, May 24, 1999 N.99 “State policy of the Russian Federation relating to Russian citizens living abroad” (hereinafter “Federal Law N.99).
4. Compatriots, who are living abroad and not having Russian citizenship are not covered the special admission rules for the educational programs according to the Federal Law N. 273, unless otherwise provided by international agreements of the Russian Federation.
5. For foreign citizens and stateless citizens admitted to the educational program based on commercial contracts, using an intermediary language (English), the University establishes at least two entrance exams among from the entrance exams established by the Order of the Ministry of Education and Science of the Russian Federation, 04.09.2014 N. 1204 “ Approval of the list of entrance exams for admission to study on higher educational programs”.
6. To study on the educational program 31.05.01. “Medicine” in English the foreign applicants are to pass the following exams: Chemistry (1) – written examination, Biology (2) – written examination.

- The number in parenthesis indicate the priority of the entrance examinations established by University.

7. Entrance exams for foreign citizens and stateless citizens admitted without the using of intermediary language conducted by University as a written test. Optionally, the Unified State Exam for subjects included in the list and defined in paragraph 21 of these Rules may be the form of the entrance test.

8. Foreign citizens applying for study without the use of an intermediary language, of oneself, pass all entrance exams in writing form or pass one or more of these entrance tests along with the provision of the exam results as the results of other entrance tests.

9. The University independently allocates the number of places for foreign citizens admitting with use of an intermediary language, as long as the list of the entrance exams for this category of citizens is differs from the list of exams for other persons.

10. The University sets the following admission dates:

- start accepting documents – June 20, 2020;
- deadline for accepting documents from persons entering the University according to the results of entrance exams conducted by University – July 10, 2020;
- deadline for accepting documents from persons entering the University according to the results of entrance exams conducted by University at the places allocated for foreign citizens entering the study using the intermediary language – August 14, 2020;

- deadline for entrance examinations conducted by the University independently, deadline of acceptance of documents required for admission from persons entering the study without passing entrance exams – July 26, 2020;

- the deadline for the University’s own entrance examinations for foreign citizens applying for educational programs at places specially designated by the University with the use of English language – August 20, 2020.

Entrance examinations for foreign citizens are carried out in accordance with the established schedule, which posted on the official website of the University and at the stand of the commission for admission to students.

11. Foreign applicants have to indicate in the admission application form the details of an identify document or a document proving the identity of a foreign citizen in the Russian Federation or the identity of a stateless person in accordance with article 10 of the Federal Law of July 25,2002 N.115 “The legal status of foreign citizens in the Russian Federation” and provide original or copy of the identify document in accordance with subparagraph 1 paragraph 66 of these Rules.

12. Upon admission to education the compatriot shall submit, in addition to the documents specified in paragraph 66 of these Rules, originals or copies of the documents provided in Article 17 of the Federal Law N.99;

13. Foreign citizens entering on the basis of international treaties additionally provide documents confirming their classification as persons indicated in the relevant international treaties;

14. Foreign citizens entering within the Russian Government quota (08.10.2013 “Establishing the quota for education of the foreign citizens and stateless citizens in Russian Federation”) provide, in addition to the listed documents, the direction of the Ministry of Education and Science of the Russian Federation;

15. Foreign citizens who, in accordance with international treaties or Federal Laws, are entitled to receive higher education on an equal basis with citizens of the Russian Federation, participate in general competitions for places within the framework of benchmarks and places under agreements on the provision of paid educational services for citizens of the Russian Federation.

Foreign citizens who are also citizens of the Russian Federation are considered by the Russian Federation only as citizens of the Russian Federation,
